TYPE OF FRATERNITY

Kappa Alpha Psi $(KA\Psi)$ is a collegiate Greek-letter fraternity.

Kappa Alpha Psi is a social fraternity focused on supporting the purposes of colleges and universities.

Each Greek letter chapter recognizes that its privilege and responsibilities differ in no way from those of other groups comprising the institutional community.

The ideals, purposes, and procedures of Kappa Alpha Psi are never intended to be inconsistent with college's ideals, purpose and procedures.

KAPPA ALPHA PSI FOUNDING DATE

The Fraternity is founded on January 5, 1911 on the campus of Indiana University Bloomington, Indiana.

Founder **Elder W. Diggs** called the founders together on January 5, 1911 to form a permanent organization.

The chosen name was **Kappa Alpha Nu** as a tribute to a group of Black students at Indiana University in 1903 who organized the **Alpha Kappa Nu** club to foster a better life for Blacks on campus.

Kappa Alpha Psi Incorporation Date

Chartered and incorporated originally under the laws of the State of Indiana as Kappa Alpha Nu on May 15, 1911, the name was changed to KAPPA ALPHA PSI on a resolution offered and adopted at the Grand Chapter in December 1914. This change became effective April 15, 1915, on a proclamation by the then Grand Polemarch, *Elder Watson Diggs*.

Thus, the name acquired a distinctive Greek letter symbol and KAPPA ALPHA PSI thereby became a Greek letter Fraternity in every sense of the designation

KAPPA ALPHA PSI OFFICIAL FLOWERS

The official flower has evolved into a **carnation with a crimson tint** because of its fragrance and beauty.



Kappa Alpha Psi Official Colors

The official Colors of the Fraternity are *CRIMSON* and *CREAM*. Crimson is by no means a traditional Red. Rather, it is a deep red shade. Cream is a pale yellow hue.

While there is no factual reference as to why these colors - **CRIMSON** and **CREAM** – were selected, the color scheme does closely identify the Fraternity with the Bloomington campus of Indiana University (IU). IU's official colors are crimson and cream.

The formal dedication of the 2322-24 North Broad Street site was held on July 6,1991.
